The Vietnam Memorial Traveling Wall is an 80% sized replica of the wall in Washington, DC, standing over 8' tall at the apex and over 370 feet long.

Thursday, June 24 – Opening day. Dedicated to honoring Disabled American Veterans, members of the American Legion, Veterans of Foreign Wars, Vietnam Veterans of America, and Veterans-at-large. Keynote speakers, live music and special events throughout the day, including Candlelight Memorial Ceremony with reading of names of those on the wall from Burlington County with presentation to their attending families.

Friday, June 25 – Dedicated to honoring law enforcement and fire department personnel, EMT's, Paramedics, Civic Leaders, and others. Police, fire and emergency equipment on exhibit. Keynote speakers, live music and special events throughout the day.

Saturday, June 26 - Dedicated to honoring active duty military personnel and their families. Keynote speakers, live music and other events throughout the day, including a tentative flyover of special military aircraft at 12:30.

Sunday, June 27 – Special church service, keynote speakers, live music and other events throughout the day, including the Bikers Ride of Honor at 3:00 p.m.
